

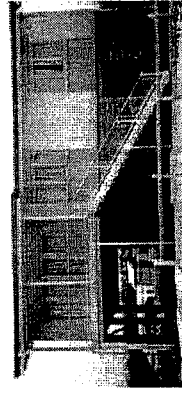
## LOCAL MAN

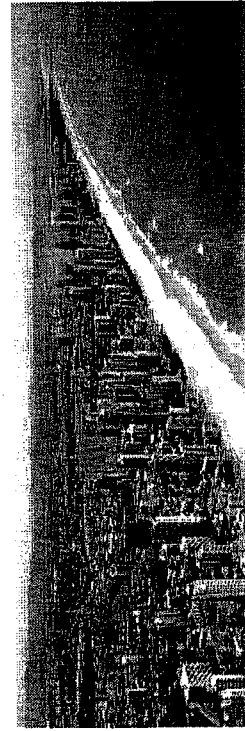

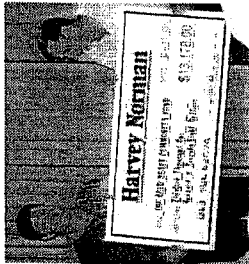

You will be eligible for a postal vote if you are unable to attend a polling booth on Election Day because you will be:

- more than 8km away from your nearest voting booth
- prevented from voting due to work or travel
- prevented from voting due to religious beliefs
- under detention on polling day
- prevented from voting at a polling booth due to illness, disability or advanced pregnancy\*
- prevented from voting at a polling booth due to caring for a person who is ill, has a disability or is pregnant

\* denotes you are entitled to vote by means of an electoral visit.

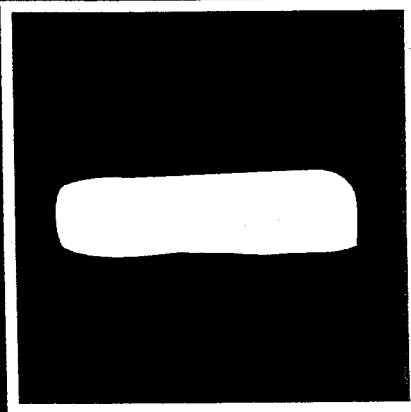
