APPENDIX ONE – Refer to Procedure Training Requirements for Custodial Positions

Note: In this table “custodial position” is defined as a Custodial Correctional Officer, Correctional Supervisor, Correctional Supervisor Dog Squad, Dog Handler, Field Officer, Farm Officer, Trade Instructor and Activities Officer.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cultural Awareness	All Queensland Corrective Services (QCS) employees having direct offender contact as part of their usual employment in corrective services facilities and Escort and Security Branch	3 years
Provide Basic Life Support	All custodial positions that manage / supervise offenders	CPR – 12 months Provide Basic Life Support - 3 years
Chemical Agents	All QCS employees who are identified by the general manager of the facility.	3 years
Control and Restraint	All custodial positions	12 months
Emergency Response Training	All custodial positions identified by the general manager of the facility.	12 months
Firearms	All custodial positions that are authorised by an approved delegate and are required to carry firearms as part of their duties.	12 months
Provide First Aid	All QCS employees who are— a) firearm instructors; b) chemical agents instructors; c) Escort and Security Branch; d) Low Custody officers	CPR – 12 months Provide First Aid – 3 years
Fire Response	All QCS employees	12 months
Suicide Prevention/Awareness	All QCS employees having direct offender contact as part of their usual employment.	3 years
Control Room	All custodial positions identified by the general manager of the facility.	As required
Dog Handler Training	All corrective services dog handlers who are authorised to manage and train corrective services dogs.	12 months
