Please accept my late submission.

My name is [REDACTED] I have been involved in the sex industry in Queensland for the past 12 years. I have had experience in the brothel, private, legal and illegal industry. I was a foundation member of [REDACTED] and on the first Governance committee of this [REDACTED] organisation. I am the owner of [REDACTED] Queensland escort directories which have over 100 private sex workers advertising. These websites are listed below.

Safety is of the most importance when it comes to the sex industry. If a worker feels safe then their general health and well being is better thus ensuring a safer healthy general community.

Safety is and always has been found in numbers. I feel the industry would be greatly improved by permitting two workers to reside and work from the same residence. This would improve the safety levels of private workers, not only would there be someone about in case of emergency but the clients would quickly become aware of the new laws and be aware that someone could be about.

Private workers security would be improved by the presence of a reception / phone lady who makes bookings on or off the premiss's or by a cleaner doing the laundry.

Out Calls By Private workers: the private worker should be able to be walked to the door of the clients hotel or residence by her driver. The worker should be able to have her phone lady call her upon arrival to confirm all is OK. The phone lady should also be able to call her 5 minutes before the job is to finish to make transport arrangements.

Out Calls By Brothels and agencies: No advantage to the security of sex workers.
