Sir/Madam,

I am not big on coincidence and there seems a case of such at present.

My previous 10 page letter to you - not of any crime as such, but of my conduct bordering on corruption I see it did to such events described have no doubt been imbedded into corrective services way of operating for a long time - states that there is a "requirement under COP requirements" to have a psychologist, in the Centre I am housed, interview me each month.

Given my letter to you would have been received about 3 to 4 weeks ago, and the CCC have been at Arthur Gorrie Correctional Centre during the last few weeks, and the Centre's psychological unit had not followed such "requirements" regarding me since

July 2017, then it's very coincidental that a psych
comes to see me on Friday 4th May 2018 out of
left field.

My letter to you was to outline / highlight a
number of things that have happened here (at this
Correctional Centre which, I believe, is imbedded
into the way of operating into most, if not all,
Correctional centres in Queensland.

As such, the system needs fixing, not for your
organization to be a band-aid effect, then go
away and let collections go back to normal
operations.

Managers of Correctional centres, Directors of
areas within Correctional services, those appointed to
run such units of services in collections — they too
need to be held to account.

Because that is the problem. There is no
ACCOUNTABILITY within collective services as a whole
and definitely within individual Correctional centres.

I feel it is your responsibility, given it's now
in your hands, to rectify this once and for all.

Otherwise it is CORRUPTION and as such this
CORRUPTION stems from your organization down
because you won't fix the problems.
