Statement of Constantine William Nikiforides

- 1. I am the Chief Executive Officer of the Niecon Group of which Blue Sky Capital Pty Ltd is one of its companies. The directors of that company are William Nikiforides and Barry Francis Cronin. Barry Francis Cronin is the company solicitor and has no interest in the company, legal or otherwise. William Nikiforides is my father, who has been unwell for some years and takes no active part in the affairs of the Niecon Group or Blue Sky Capital Pty Ltd.
- 2. Over the years various entities in the Niecon Group have made donations to political candidates. Specifically during the past eighteen months, these include:
 - (a) a \$1,000.00 contribution to the McPherson Federal Campaign by way of a breakfast and boat cruise with Margaret May MP and Alexander Downer on 14 July 2005;
 - (b) \$5,000.00 to Gary Baildon by payment to the Gary Baildon Campaign Fund on 16 March 2004;
 - (c) \$5,000.00 on 29 January 2004 to the Nationals Campaign;
 - (d) \$2,000.00 to the campaign for the re-election of Peter Lawlor, Member for Southport on 5 February 2004;
 - (e) payment of \$695.00 on 11 May 2005 for the 2008 re-election of Ted Shepherd at a wine tasting function at Mudgeeraba.
- 3. The above are only the recent donations. Niecon Group has made other political donations over about 15 years. .
- 4. A few days before 17 March 2004 I had a telephone conversation with Brian Ray who is now deceased as a result of a recent tragic airplane crash. I had a long standing relationship with Brian Ray. Both of us were in the development industry and we exchanged information about the market, consultants, contractors and that type of information.
- 5. During the course of this conversation, Brian Ray said that he was organising a fund to assist Councillors and candidates who were prepared to get things done on the Gold Coast. He said he wanted to

generate democratic debate about what should be occurring on the Gold Coast and he thought that a fund would assist Councillors and candidates who would be supportive and positive of this approach. He wanted me to make a contribution of \$10,000.00 to the fund which would assist those Councillors and candidates who would make a positive contribution to the Gold Coast. He asked me to come to a meeting at his office to meet with him and with others. Brian Ray was a person with a lot of people skills and if he asked you for a donation for what seemed a good cause, it was difficult to refuse. On other occasions I have asked Ray to donate to charitable causes in the past, and he has always done that.

- 6. I went to Brian Ray's office at 5.00 pm on 17 March 2004. The only other person at that meeting was Councillor David Power. This was the first time I ever met David Power. Brian Ray did most of the talking, but there was discussion about councillors who were positive and who worked to try and get things to happen on the Gold Coast. He said that he proposed to arrange a meeting at which people could meet councillors and candidates. The meeting lasted only about 20 minutes.
- 7. I recall David Power saying that he supported a meeting at which councillors and potential candidates would be able to discuss what they represented, and people could get to know them. He thought that at some stage party politics would enter into the local elections on the Gold Coast but at this stage that hadn't occurred and contributing to a campaign fund was one way towards assisting those who would make a positive contribution towards developing the infrastructure necessary on the Gold Coast.
- 8. I thought the fund was to be controlled by Brian Ray and that the meeting would be held with the existing or potential councillors. To my knowledge, that meeting did not occur.
- 9. I recall receiving an email from Brian Ray on 1 March 2004. He rang me that day and asked me about making the \$10,000.00 contribution. I told him I hadn't received his earlier email, which he said he sent on 24 February 2004, and he sent it to me again. Even then I held back until I received a further call from him sometime around about a week or two prior to the elections, reminding me that I had to send the money. It was only then that I authorised the company accountant Ron Veness to draw the cheque. Details of payment of the cheque to Hickey Lawyers were included in the email from Brian Ray.



- 10. I do not know anything about the Lionel Barden Common Sense Fund or any similar name. That had not been mentioned to me, and I knew nothing about it.
- I have met Lionel Barden. I first met him formally at a function called Innovation Showcase at the Gold Coast Airport, which was a Business Leaders meet Gary Baildon function. It was held on 16 March 2004. There was a further meet the candidates function on 25 March 2004 which I did not attend. I have never discussed the elections with him. Subsequently I met him on other occasions but the subject of Council elections has not been discussed.
- 12. Over the past twenty-five years my family has been developing property on the Gold Coast and during that time we have had contact with many councillors and many council officers. I have never received any favours out of the Gold Coast City Council. I find the current Council a very difficult Council to deal with in the sense of being difficult to have a development approved. From time to time I or my staff or consultants have telephoned councillors or council officers about particular developments or different development issues to discuss these issues with them. This is a regular activity of our business.






