Ahh but I do know that there's a grave concern in the community that there's umm ahh benefits that might come to some people who've made donations and in particular Hope Island is one of those areas that's received a lot of attention from the community whereby Councillor Pforr seems to have a close relationship with some of the development interests – in particular Mr Fish – ahh in a public sense and umm there's been a lot of umm dissent in the community about umm intensifying the development capabilities on the Island both from ahh amenity and transportation and service provision aspects and others. Ahh Councillor Pforr has openly rejected all of those – that dissent from the community and has seemingly sided himself very strongly with the development interests and so ahh that's highlighted that concern in the public's mind about ahh the potential of ahh influence to be brought to bear to benefit those people. Now umm the evidence of that umm benefit isn't probably going to be in a Council Agenda and umm Mr Needham again has ahh made it apparent that his perception or his ahh interpretation of ahh conflict of interest doesn't mean - doesn't cover someone getting funding from, for an election and then voting in favour of a development item for example but only if by voting on that thing there's a possible benefit in the future which seems to be an extraordinary, extraordinarily difficult thing to prove.
