STATEMENT OF CRAIG GRANVILLE TREASURE

I, Craig Granville Treasure, Company Director, will say:

- 1. I am a director of Sunland Group Limited ("SGL") and have authority on behalf of SGL to make this statement.
- In response to the Notice to Discover dated 12 August 2005 and served on SGL, I respond as follows.
- 3. In relation to the matters set out in paragraph 1 of the schedule, the relevant documents are:

A.

- (i) Undated invitation on behalf of Councillor Ted Shepherd to a function on 12 November 2003
- (ii) A cheque and remittance advice drawn on SGL account with Westpac Banking Corporation at Surfers Paradise in the State of Queensland in favour of Ted Shepherd Campaign Account, 20 October 2003

B.

- (i) Email from Brian Ray to Heidi Walsh (SGL), 14 January 2004
- (ii) Cheque and remittance advice in favour of Hickey Lawyers Trust Account, 28 January 2004

C.

- (i) Email from Heidi Walsh to Pauline Drewson (SGL), 27 May 2004
- (ii) Cheque and remittance advice in favour of Max Christmas Campaign Fund, 27 May 2004
- (iii) Letter Max Christmas to SGL attaching receipt, 28 May 2004

D.

- (i) Tax invoice from Quadrant to SGL, 1 November 2004
- (ii) Remittance advice, 15 November 2004
- 4. Copies of these documents are **attached**.
- 5. In response to paragraph 2, the following information is provided in relation to each group of documents identified above.

Group A

6. In or about the end of October 2003 and on behalf of SGL, I accepted an invitation to attend a function organised on behalf of Councillor Ted Shepherd in connection with his campaign for re-election as a member of the Gold Coast City Council. The company chose to make a donation to the campaign in the sum of \$2,000. A cheque in that amount in favour of Ted Shepherd

Campaign Account was drawn on the company's account with Westpac Banking Corporation

Group B

7. Following a discussion between the late Brian Ray and the joint managing director of SGL, Soheil Abedian, SGL agreed to make a general donation in favour of candidates standing for election at the forthcoming Gold Coast City Council. The cheque which was drawn in favour of Hickey Lawyers Trust Account as requested by Mr Ray was not in support of any particular candidate; SGL had no information about the identity of any candidate or candidates who might ultimately benefit from the general donation. The cheque in the sum of \$10,000 was drawn on the company's account with Westpac Banking Corporation at Surfers Paradise. Group C

- On 27 May 2004, cheques were drawn on the company's account with Westpac Banking 8. Corporation as follows: (a)
 - Max Christmas Campaign Fund in the sum of \$3,000; and
 - Gary Baildon Campaign Fund in the sum of \$18,000. (b)
- Subsequently, a letter was received from Max Christmas dated 28 May acknowledging receipt of 9. Group D

- 10. Some time in October 2004, the company received a request from Tony Hickey of Hickey Lawyers for assistance in payment of expenses incurred in relation to the Gold Coast City Council election generally on behalf of candidates supported by the Lionel Barden Trust Fund. 11.
- The company was informed that Quadrant had incurred a number of expenses on behalf of the Fund in relation to the campaign, which remained unpaid. 12.
- Shortly after that, I was contacted by someone I believe to be an employee of Quadrant, although I do not now recall their name, who repeated this request for assistance with payment of expenses 13.
- I said that the company would consider the request if it received information about the expenses, 14.
- The invoice which is document D1 was received shortly after that conversation, at or about the beginning of November 2004. The invoice for \$7,700 was approved for payment on 15.
- Subsequently, the amount of \$7,700 was remitted by telegraphic transfer from the company's account with Westpac Banking Corporation to Quadrant in accordance with the particulars set out on the document which is D2. In general

- 16. All of these payments were made by the company as donations, either to the particular campaign fund to which they were directed or more generally in support of candidates standing for election to the Gold Coast City Council. 17.
- In response to paragraph 3 of the Notice, the documents previously described and the information relating to those documents provided in the preceding paragraphs comprise all of the documents in the possession or under the control of the company and all of the information which is either

personally known to me or which, having made due enquiry within the company, I have been able to identify as relating to the company's financial dealings with any of the persons or entities


