RÚLE:

Multiply the principal by as many one hundredths as there are days, and then divide as follows:

Percent 4 5 6 7 8 9 10
Divide by 90 72 60 52 45 40 36

EXAMPLES:

Interest on \$100, for 90 days at 5 percent:

100 X .90 = 90.00 divided by 72 = 1.25 (1 dollar and 25 cents); on \$1, for 30 days at 6 percent: 1 X .30 = .30 divided by 60 = .005 (5 mills).
