



Jabiru Island

We need to find an alternative solution to the proposed ferry terminal at Jabiru Island. In the best interests of Couran Cove, Grant Pforr agrees that the current Runaway Bay Marina is under huge pressure, but does not agree with a terminal at Jabiru Island. Grant is currently communicating with all parties regarding several alternative locations.

Road Improvements

Grant Pforr will continue to work with all parties for the upgrades of Hope Island Road and Oxley Drive. Grant also plans to eliminate rat running by slowing down through-traffic along residential streets. More parking will be added with public consultation at Broadwater and Paradise Point Shopping Centre under Grant's initiative. He also plans to address the issue of whether the current public transport system can sufficiently support the high level of infrastructure.

Sensible Water Management – without raising rates!

- Current Hinze Dam level is now 80%*
- Grant Pforr supports the push for raising the dam wall to Stage 3. • Stage 3 of the dam raising proposal would result in an increase that would more than double the current water capacity of the Hinze Dam

and improve flood mitigation.

- The dam has been built for 14 years and has overflowed 12 times. Raising the dam wall by 4m for flood mitigation only will cost \$34 million. Stage 3 however, would see the dam raised by 16m at a cost of \$80 million, providing both increased water storage and flood mitigation. In the event of a flood, this action could save a reported \$114 million in flood damage costs.
- There is currently over \$55 million in Gold Coast City Council trust accounts from development contributions for water supply Capital Works.
 Council also has the ability to attract a 40% subsidy (estimated \$32 million) on water storage capital works under current State Government Funding policy.
- Grant supports the proposal to combine these two funding sources to commit to Stage 3 construction without raising Gold Coast rates.
