I, Desmond James Campbell description of the State do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows –

- I hold a Real Estate Sales Person's Certificate under the Property Agents and Motor
 Dealers Act and I am employed as a Real Estate Sales Person at Ashmore First National

 Real Estate at 115 Currumburra Road Ashmore in the State of Queensland.
- 2. In August 2004 I was approached by Fred Loeskow in relation to the property at 167 Hinkler Drive, Carrara (Lot 57 on RP 840715 and Lot 28 on WD 4657, Parish of Gilston). The property was then owned by his uncle Robert Anthes from whom he held a power of attorney. He asked me to seek out expressions of interest in relation to the property, and he executed a formal appointment of Ashmore First National Real Estate in Form 22a.
- 3. The property has an area of 343.3 hectares and it was (and is) zoned rural.
- 4. I was aware that the property would be of interest to developers. I sent an information package which had been prepared by Warren Morton (Town Planner and Engineer) to the Raptis Group, Australand, Stockland and the Sunland Group, and some others, and invited expressions of interest. Shortly after I sent out the information packages I received a telephone call from Craig Treasure of the Sunland Group. I did not know him but I have since learned from the Sunland website that he is a director of the company.
- 5. Mr Treasure told me that he was from Sunland and that they were interested in the property. He told me that they knew the land and had been monitoring it for a number of years, and that they had in mind doing an extensive residential subdivision. He asked me who else had received an information package and I told him the names of some of the people to whom I had sent one. He then said to me that I should let the vendor know that Sunland could get the development through Council, because they had contributed to the Councillors' election fund.

- 6. I understood the reference to the Councillors' election fund to relate to contributions to the Lionel Barden Trust Fund which I had read about in the press. I understood the statement to mean that, because of the donations which it had made, Sunland would receive favourable treatment from the Council, and for that reason the vendor should deal with them because Sunland would be able to get approval for the development of the land, which others might not be able to get. I was shocked at what he had said.
- 7. Mr Treasure told me that he would contact Warren Morton about the land. I did not hear anything further from him and because I was disturbed at the ethics his suggestion that Sunland would get favoured treatment because of contributions made to the re-election funds of Councillors I did not contact him again.
- 8. I informed Fred Loeskow of the approach from Mr Treasure, and of what he had said about Sunland's donation to Councillors' election funds.
