An Open Letter to the Chairman of the CCC

Dear Mr McSporan,

I write to you because of the severity of this matter. I refer to the interview did on the ABC News on the 29th March 2018. You made comments about my personal matter during this segment.

My address was given out by police officer Neil Punchard to my former partner. He breached my privacy and unlawfully accessed the Police Database to provide personal details to a perpetrator who had and has threatened to kill my children and I.

These threats are current and these threats are real. I know that the perpetrator has the intention to carry out these threats. In the meantime I strongly believe that Neil Punchard continues to aid and abet the perpetrator! After all he has already helped out his friend.

I initially complained about this to the CCC who then referred the matter back to the QPS to investigate.

I note in this interview you say - "I don't know why there were no criminal charges" my question to you is that, as the Chairman of the CCC why don't you know? I was told the CCC were monitoring this investigation by the QPS.

You also say "The explanation wasn't good enough". I agree with you, it wasn't good enough. What steps did you take are you you to take to remedy the response being inadequate?

You add further, "I think we have an obligation to that complainant and the community at large to explain why"

You have not made contact with me to explain why. Why not?

My matter has featured on the front page of the Courier Mail, and the video of the story went viral online, and yet, still this officer is employed by the QPS and you have not explained to either myself or the community that place their trust in you to oversee this kind of unlawful conduct and why this has been accepted by you. It appears to be clear that you failing to act on this matter is acceptance of it.

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What protection do I have since speaking out about this officer from retaliation or my privacy further being breached?

I now feel like I am in a far more vulnerable position, and I am disappointed that your priority was to talk to the media not me directly. Is this how you choose to help victims of crime and violence.
